

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## ABSTRACT

The research topic was factors that contribute to preschool children dropout in Muremma Preschool, Kasarani Division, Nairobi Province.

During the study the researcher used the questionnaire method to collect data from the field. The people who participated in the study included Muremma Preschool head teacher, teachers and parents.

The following were identified as causes of preschool children dropout in the preschool:-

HIV/AIDS scourge which makes many families poor .Families are unable to cater for preschool education expenses and free primary education that makes parents overlook preschool level of learning.

The outstanding cause of preschool dropout was the impact of free primary education. Many parents did not have stable income to meet preschool education cost of their children. This forced them to prefer free primary education at the expense of preschool education.
